

Ceremony The Golden Sun

Schedule:

- Opening by organizers of the country where the ceremony takes place
- Introduction by Frouk Riemersma
- Explanation Ceremony
- Ceremony
- Drinks and exchange of experiences

Expected duration: 2 hours

Preparation

The organizers of the Ceremony have gathered 51 (local) representatives representing the European countries. Those can be people who actually come from that country or are deeply related to that country by origin or family. Or people who want to join the ceremony and are willing to connect themselves to a specific European country. If less than 51 representatives, people do more countries.

The Ceremony

A big cloth (10 by 10 meter) is spread out on the ground. In the middle of the carpet, the outer lines of all 52 pieces of the Golden Sun are embroidered with goldthread. Around this embroidered middle lie 52 wooden pieces. Around this all representatives sit on a chair, meditation cushion or on the carpet.

The pieces are numbered in a way that the first one will be put in the middle, from which a spiral forms till The Golden Sun arises. Under each piece lies a paper with the name and some pictures of the country which is connected to that piece.

One by one, the representatives stand up, speak out loud his/her name and pick up the wooden piece in front of him/her. After a short silence he/she puts the piece on the right spot in the centre of the carpet. Than he/she sits down and the next person is on turn, till alle pieces are lied down and Th Golden Sun arises.

Piece number 52 represents the connection between Europe and the World. On this piece lies a bundle that contains cristals and stones.

When the Sun is completed, we all stand up and form a circle by giving each other a hand. We let flow our intentions through our left hand into the big circle of the 51 representatives, melting it to one connection. That we sent all over the continent Europe, into the world.

Next to participants, spectators also are very welcome.

What do you need to organize a Ceremony?

- An indoor location, free of charge
- 25-52 People who like to join a Ceremony for peace in Europe. If there are less than 52 people in the Ceremony, people change places and do double.
- 2 Hours for the Ceremony, 2 Hours preparation, 2 hours cleaning up.
- A financial support to cover the costs of transport and travelling. This contribution can be collected among the participants.
